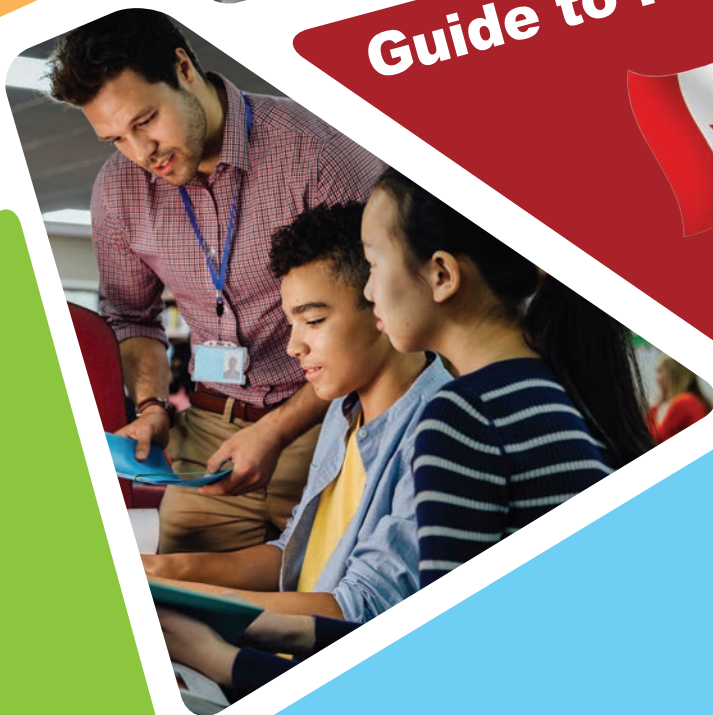

Canada's public education system consists of schools from Kindergarten to Grade 12 (or Grade 11 in Québec — see *Why Study in Québec* for further details). All public schools in Canada are provincially accredited, follow a standard curriculum, employ only government certified teachers, and are publicly funded. While the education system in each province contains many similarities, each has its own curriculum and guidelines to reflect the culture and history of its region. Over 95% of Canadians choose public school education for their children.

Canada spends more on education (per capita) than any other country in the G8. Canadian public high school students consistently rank near the top in the world on standardized tests. Canadian high school graduation diplomas are recognized throughout the world.

Canada's public schools have been accepting international students since the 1980s, have well-developed infra-structure and support including ESL (English as a Second Language) and FSL (French as a Second Language) instruction as well as carefully supervised homestay programs. Almost all public schools are co-educational and accept international students for high school graduation programs or for shorter stays of weeks, months or a year or two. Many elementary schools also accept young students for short term and full-year programs.

Most school boards offer non-religious education although in a few provinces some faith-based schools are also publicly funded.

Elementary* — Elementary schools provide educational programs for students from Kindergarten and Grade 1 through to Grades 4, 5, 6, or 7. These early years provide an important foundation for lifelong learning.

Middle* — Middle schools typically enrol students in grades 5, 6, 7 and 8 however the specific grades offered may vary by school and region. Middle school prepares students for junior high and high school grades.

Junior High* — Junior high schools generally include Grades 7, 8 and 9 and provide a transition for students from elementary to high/secondary school.

Secondary or High Schools* — Secondary or high schools offer opportunities for students beginning in Grade 8, 9 or 10 to continue their studies through to Grade 12 (or Grade 11 in Québec) to complete graduation requirements. These schools offer students more choice and opportunity to specialize in their particular areas of interest while preparing for post-secondary education and future careers. Where offered, qualified students may also enrol in the International Baccalaureate Program or take Advanced Placement (AP) courses.

Affordability & High Standard of Living

Each year, thousands of international students and their parents choose Canada as a study destination because tuition fees are competitively priced yet provide a high standard of living. The standard of living in Canada is among the highest in the world.

Choosing a School and Educational Program

All school boards/districts across Canada offer educational programs from Kindergarten through to Grade 12 (5-18 years) or Grade 11 in Québec. However, which programs are offered to international students will vary. School structures and grade groupings also vary throughout the

country. In Canada, international students can choose to study and live in small towns with rural settings, suburban, mid-size communities, or in larger urban cities. Selecting a school is an important decision, however all CAPS-I public schools offer the highest quality learning experiences in friendly welcoming schools.

All CAPS-I schools have knowledgeable and well-trained staff to assist international students and ensure they are registered for the appropriate academic and optional courses to suit their language ability, personal interests, and future goals.

As students progress through the grades, they are provided with more choice of optional courses and specialized programming (subject to availability) including: Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, sports & fine arts academies, apprenticeship, and French Immersion opportunities to name just a few.

International students have a very comprehensive network of caring and supportive individuals that are ready and willing to assist at all stages of their learning experience. International students are also well supported and cared for outside of the classroom and school community as well. Most international students will live with a local host family and be in regular communication with the Homestay Coordinator.

All of the people involved in the students 'circle of care and support' are of course available to answer any questions from the parents of the international students as well. Parents of international students are encouraged to remain informed and in contact throughout their child's study program.

Unfortunately all experiences whether short or long term must eventually come to an end. International students either return home or move onto further their studies at the post-secondary level. International programs, homestays, and school staff also support students through this departure and transition process.

How to Apply

Each school or group of schools has a unique registration form. Complete the registration form for the school of choice and then submit it with the required documents.

Remember to note application deadlines!

Once a student's application has been accepted and tuition fees have been paid, an Official Letter of Acceptance will be issued to the student. Be sure to apply for a study permit as soon as the Official Letter of Acceptance has been received. Visit the Citizenship & Immigration Canada website for more information about the study permit application process:

The student's study permit and visa as necessary must be applied for and received before coming to Canada.

Host Family Accommodations

Living with a host family provides an excellent opportunity for international students to develop conversational English and/or French skills and experience life as part of a typical Canadian family.

CAPS-I member homestay programs will provide a carefully selected Canadian host family including:

- a warm, welcoming, and friendly living environment
- parenting, support, and guidance
- a furnished private bedroom
- a study area
- three meals per day and snacks
- an introduction to the community

All CAPS-I programs adhere to prescribed practices to ensure that their host families are carefully and appropriately screened before they are selected into the program to ensure they are:

- friendly and caring
- English and/or French-speaking (primary language spoken in the home)
- able to complete successfully a criminal record check with the local police department
- able to successfully complete a reference check process
- willing to welcome an international student into their family
- willing to include the student in their family and community activities
- interested in learning about other cultures and customs

Québec's education system has five levels: elementary (K-6), high school (7-11), vocational (skilled trades offered through professional centres), college (CEGEP 2-3 year programs), and university. Students in the province of Québec who intend to pursue post-secondary education must attend CEGEP before enrolling in university in Québec. CEGEP is an acronym for College

d'enseignement general et professionnel, or "General and Vocational College".

Québec

It is exclusive to the education system in Québec.

Students complete one grade fewer in total (finishing in Grade 11) than all other Canadian students before beginning post-secondary studies. CEGEP then prepares the students for university or to enter a technical profession. Most Québec undergraduate programs are three years, hence, the total number of years of study from elementary school through a Bachelor's degree is the same as in the rest of North America.

International students wishing to continue their university education outside of Québec in another province or in their home country must take an additional one year of courses to fulfill the requirements of the university to which they are applying.

Since 1867, the Central Québec School Board (CQSB) has provided high-quality education to the English-speaking community of Québec. Our geographical territory, the largest in Québec, covers nearly one-third of the province. 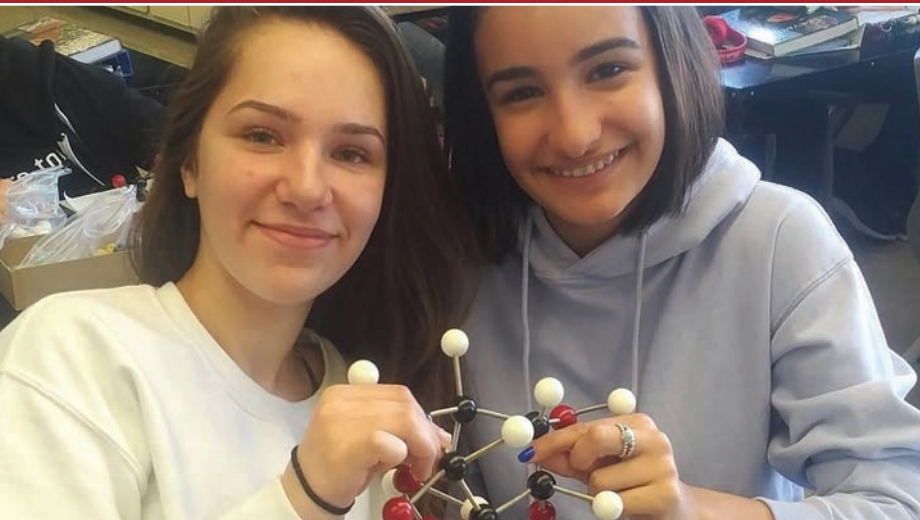

Why Study in Nova Scotia



Vibrant communities, modern schools.

Located on Canada's Atlantic Coast, Nova Scotia has a population of just over one million people. Famous for its natural beauty, Nova Scotia is a popular tourist destination with more than 7,600 kilometres of coastline to explore. The province is comprised of modern cities, vibrant towns, and coastal and rural villages. Halifax International Airport is conveniently located less than a two-hour flight from Toronto and New York.

The Nova Scotia International Student Program (NSISP) annually welcomes more than 1,500 students from 35 countries, making it one of Canada's largest and most diverse public high

school programs. NSISP policies limit the number of international students from one country to six students per school, ensuring all program participants have a Canadian study experience.

Nova Scotia is ideal for students who wish to live in vibrant communities while studying in modern, welcoming schools that offer a learning environment based on academic needs and student interests.

By choosing the NSISP, you will receive an incredible immersion in the language, music, art, sport, and lifestyle of North America.

Nova Scotia's public education system is one of the best in the world. The provincial

education system prepares students for continued success in post-secondary training, which most NSISP graduates pursue. Nova Scotian schools offer a wide variety of courses, including providing the International Baccalaureate in 13 schools.

Short-term, single-semester, and/or full-year programs are available in over 75 junior and senior high schools. The Nova Scotia school year starts in September and runs for ten months ending in June. The NSISP accepts students in grades 7–12. International students can begin their program in either September or February.

All schools follow the curriculum set by the provincial government, yet each has its unique characteristics in academic programs and extra-curricular activities. There are more than 18 sports offered around the province and a wide variety of clubs and extra-curricular activities, including drama, student government, robotics, and yearbook clubs.

High schools in all seven English-speaking Regional Centres for Education and our francophone School Board (Conseil scolaire acadien provincial) accept international students. These schools are located throughout the province in both small and large communities. Students are matched with local families and schools based on their profiles. Each student is made to feel a part of the host family and is included in all celebrations, outings, and activities. This is an ideal way to “live the Nova Scotian lifestyle” firsthand. Students receive additional support from their region’s homestay coordinators and program staff.

Students’ studies and experiences prepare them to enter a Canadian or American university and succeed in the program of their choice. The NSISP has articulation agreements with all ten Nova Scotian universities providing international students with a clear pathway to scholarships and guaranteed acceptance at some of the top universities in Canada.

The NSISP philosophy is simple: by creating meaningful opportunities for cultural exchange, we prepare our students for continued success in post-secondary studies, the workplace, and life. Come to Nova Scotia to learn, grow, and become part of our proud network of over 20,000 NSISP alumni.

Oldest European-based culture in North America.

Newfoundland and Labrador has the oldest European-based culture in North America. As such, it blends old world charm with new world promise; making it a unique aspect of the Canadian cultural mosaic. It is Canada's youngest province (1949) and the only province with the distinction of having once been a country onto itself. Located in the northeast corner of North America on the edge of the dramatic and dazzling Atlantic Ocean, our province is comprised of Newfoundland—the 15th largest island in the world — and Labrador — on the Labrador Peninsula of mainland Canada, bordering Québec. With a combined landmass of 405,212 square kilometres and a population of only 541,000 people, here is a place with room to breathe.

Students will feel immediately at home in our friendly, supportive and safe schools and communities. School starts in early September and ends in late June, with an average student course load of seven to nine (7–9) courses per year. The instructional day runs from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The School

District provides a school bus for those students who are not within walking distance. The International Education Program accepts students from grades seven to twelve, and elementary students when accompanied by a parent. The experience is rich in its academic and non-academic excellence, with students learning in a safe, caring environment with academic support.

Located on Canada's East Coast, Prince Edward Island is known for its stunningly beautiful landscape, friendly hospitality, world class seafood, extraordinary culinary experiences, award winning beaches, and a thriving arts and cultural community. It is also the birthplace of author Lucy Maud Montgomery, who wrote the famous novel *Anne of Green Gables*. Prince Edward Island is truly representative of authentic Canada and offers fun and adventure along with an inspiring and endearing spirit that represents the people of our province and our great country of Canada.

Prince Edward Island is the smallest of the four Atlantic Provinces and is

separated from Nova Scotia and New Brunswick by the Northumberland Strait. You can travel to the Island by bridge, boat, or airplane. The Confederation Bridge, an engineering marvel built in 1997, is 12.9 kilometres long and allows Islanders and visitors to travel to or from Prince Edward Island and New Brunswick.

An automobile ferry runs from May to December for travel between Prince Edward Island and Nova Scotia. The airport is located in the capital city, Charlottetown and is a two hour flight from Toronto or New York.

The total land area of the Island covers

5,660 square kilometres and nowhere are you more than 16 kilometres from water. Anyone who has lived or spent time on this beautiful island will tell you there's something truly special about PEI. Prince Edward Island is quiet, peaceful, and safe with the lowest crime rate in the country. With a population of only 177,000 or so, on a tiny crescent-shaped piece of land in the Gulf of St. Lawrence, it's hard to believe so much can happen here. But, it does. Our public schools are excellent, and we care about our communities and our neighbours—it's the island way. You will find the Island to be a welcoming and endearing place to study and live!



Prince Edward Island International Student Program



Island schools follow the provincially developed curriculum of the Department of Education and Early Years and offer a wide range of programs provided by dedicated and caring staff. Students can participate in real world learning opportunities both in and out of the classroom. In Prince Edward Island we provide high quality education that is recognized world-wide and we have one of the most comprehensive English as an Additional Language (EAL) programs in Canada. We accept students into our International program in grades Kindergarten to 12. In our schools, students are encouraged to develop an appreciation and desire for life-long learning. Our goal is for students to gain the knowledge and learning experiences that will allow them to transition into an identified pathway after high school that leads to becoming globally engaged and successful citizens, who care about and want to contribute to our world.

A wide variety of extra-curricular activities and specialized programs are offered in schools and may include the following: athletic sports, music, drama, yearbook, student government, IB and French Immersion. Our program offers monthly activities for the international students to meet each other while experiencing Island recreational and cultural experiences.

We are pleased to have a partnership with a local homestay provider, Study Abroad Canada (SACL), to place students with excellent host families in Prince Edward Island. The process for admitting host families into the homestay program is a rigorous one. All families have had a thorough interview to determine suitability; have had a homestay inspection; have had references checked; passed a police record check; are enthusiastic to receive international students. Students attending elementary school (K-6) must live with a parent. No other custodianship is required, unless requested by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada.
